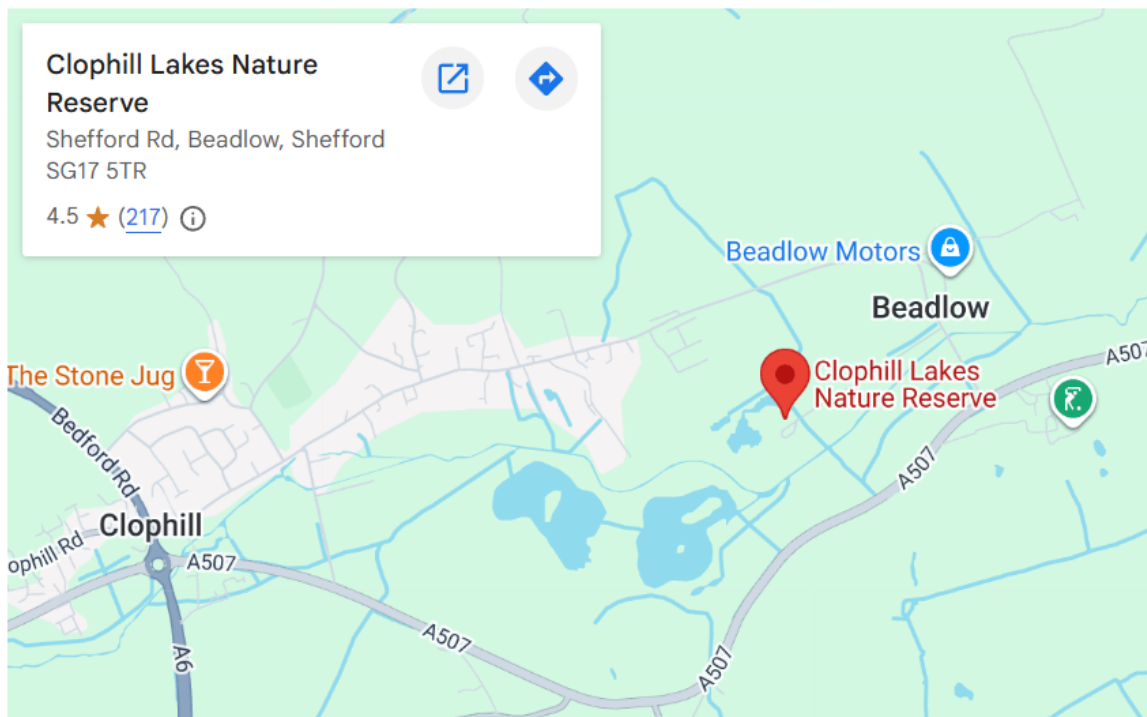

Directions to Clophill Lakes

The nature reserve is located near Clophill; easily reached from local main roads.

Clophill Lakes Nature Reserve vehicle entrance is located at: **Shefford Road, Beadlow, Beds SG17 5TR** - an alternative postcode is SG17 5PL

Please note that some sat nav systems and Google searches take visitors to Webber Close, Shefford which is SG17 5TA. Please make sure when using these systems that it is taking you to the correct site (see below) - the What3words app 'twice/half/protrude' is more reliable.



By Road

From the west - Follow the **A507 from Ampthill towards Shefford** and turn left onto Shefford Road. You'll see a brown sign for the Clophill Eco Lodges. If you go past the Cainhoe Wood Golf Club on your right you've gone too far. After turning onto Shefford Road you'll see our signs on the left.

From the east - Follow the **A507 from Shefford**, past Cainhoe Wood Golf Club on your left, you'll see a brown sign for the **Clophill Eco Lodges**. Turn right onto Shefford road, and you'll see our signs on your left.

Please avoid driving through the village if you can, we don't want to increase traffic for those who live there.

Parking

There is plenty of parking at the Reserve. Please do not park in the village but use the Clophill Lakes Nature Reserve facilities.

The Reserve has a parking fee of £3.50 to help support the Greensand Trust manage the site. This is paid prior to leaving the site. The barrier system uses vehicle registration recognition.

By Rail & Bus

The nearest railway station is Flitwick. There is a regular service to Flitwick from London and Bedford.

The Grant Palmer bus service runs from Flitwick to The Green in Clophill - 20-minute journey is available. The 15.17 service from Flitwick is scheduled to arrive at Clophill at 15.35. It is then a 25-minute walk through Clophill to reach the nature reserve.

The last bus from Clophill back to Flitwick leaves at 17.28.
